

## Hygiene concept of the Zentrum ÜBERLEBEN

**for the 22nd art auction in favor of the Überleben Stiftung für Folteropfer in the bUm/Umspannwerk on 28.11.2021. (Status: October 2021)**

The following are the key points for your auction visit:

- If you have signs of a respiratory infection such as cough, cold or fever, you may not enter the venue.
- The so-called 3-G rule applies at the venue, which means you must be recovered, vaccinated or tested to be allowed to attend the auction:
- Guests are considered GEIMPFT if they have received all vaccine doses necessary for full immunization protection - they are no longer required to be tested as of the 15th day after the last vaccine dose was administered.
- GENESED are considered persons if the positive PCR test is at least 6 months old and the administration of a vaccination dose was 14 days ago; or if the positive PCR test was at least 28 days ago up to a maximum of 6 months ago.
- The following are considered as TESTED
  1. by a negative detection (not older than 24 hours) via a rapid or PCR test, issued by a testing center;
  2. by negative evidence (not older than 24 hours) via a rapid or self-test under supervision, issued by the employer:in; or
  3. by use of a self-administered approved rapid SARS-CoV-2 antigen test under the supervision of company personnel with a negative result.

Appropriate proof of the negative test result must be provided; the information required is the first and last name of the person tested, date of birth, date and time the test was performed, name of the test and test manufacturer, test result, and the signature of the entity that performed the test.

- While in the event venue hallways, keep at least 1.5 meters away from other people, and use the marked waiting positions when forming queues. Also, be aware of our visitor flow control.
- Disinfect your hands at the entrance.
- In the event rooms, wear a protective mouth/nose mask (at least a "medical" mask, preferably an "FFP II" mask), which you may only remove when seated.
- Please refrain from shaking hands or hugging others when greeting or saying goodbye.
- Adhere to cough and sneeze etiquette. Please keep your hands away from your face; avoid touching your mouth, eyes or nose with your hands.
- Check in via attendance app or enter all required information in the attendance documentation available at your seat - we will collect it and destroy your slip after the four-week retention period.
