

Hygiene concept of the Zentrum ÜBERLEBEN

for the 22nd art auction in favor of the Überleben Stiftung für Folteropfer in the bUm/Umspannwerk on 28.11.2021. (Status: 16.11.2021)

Effective November 15, 2021, the **2G** rule applies to all public events in Berlin. To visit the Charity Auction, you must therefore be able to prove with legal certainty that you are fully vaccinated or recovered.

- Guests are considered **VACCINATED (GEIMPFT)** if they have received all vaccine doses necessary for full vaccination protection - they are no longer required to be tested after the 15th day following administration of the last vaccine dose.
- Persons are considered to be **RECOVERED (GENESEN)** if the positive PCR test was at least 6 months ago and the administration of a vaccine dose 14 days ago; or if the positive PCR test was at least 28 days ago up to a maximum of 6 months ago.

Current developments indicate that the 2G-plus regulation will be mandatory by the date of our event. In this case, each visitor will have to present a daily negative test in addition to the vaccination or recovery certificate. All documents will be checked at the entrance and have to be shown without being asked.

Below you will find the most important key points for your auction visit:

- If you have signs of a respiratory infection such as cough, cold or fever, you may not enter the venue.
- While in the event venue hallways, keep at least 1.5 meters away from other people, and use the marked waiting positions when forming queues. Also, be aware of our visitor flow control.
- Disinfect your hands at the entrance.
- In the event rooms, wear a "FFP 2" mask, which you may only remove when seated.
- Please refrain from shaking hands or hugging others when greeting or saying goodbye.
- Adhere to cough and sneeze etiquette. Please keep your hands away from your face; avoid touching your mouth, eyes or nose with your hands.
- Check in via attendance app or enter all required information in the attendance documentation available at your seat - we will collect it and destroy your slip after the four-week retention period.
- Log in via attendance app. We collect all required data in the attendance documentation (log-in list) and destroy it after the retention period of four weeks has expired.
